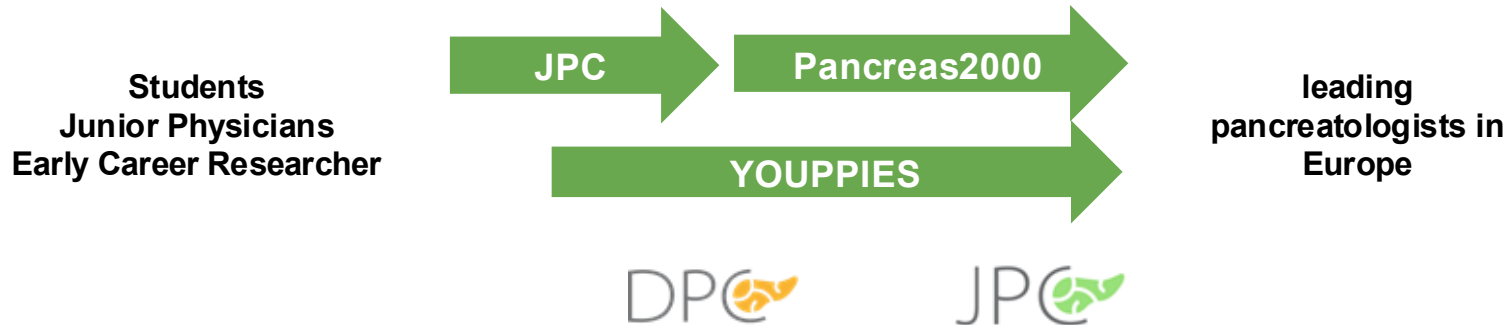
Vision

- **Early Resident Physicians** (up to 3rd year) with pancreas focus

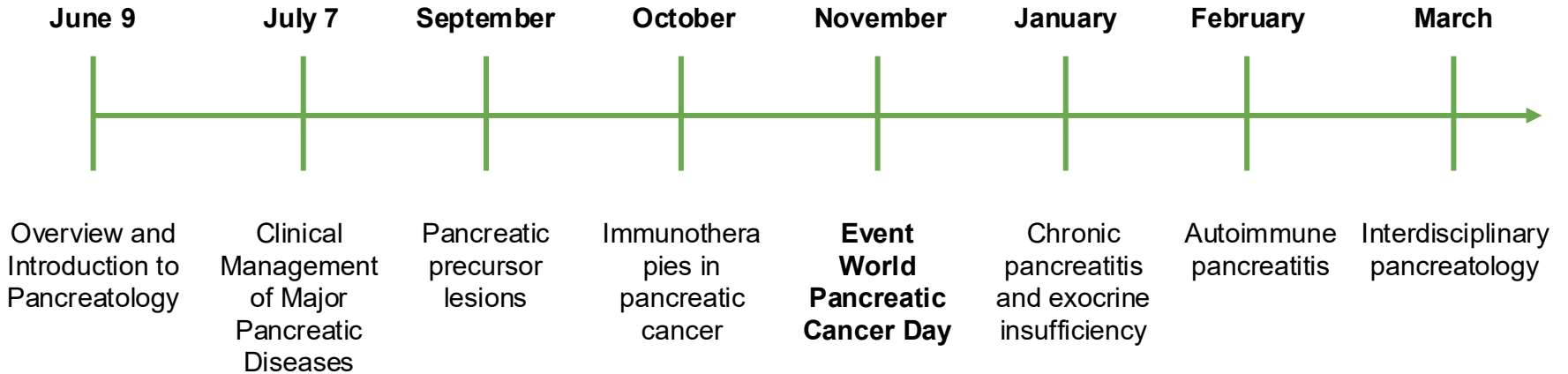


JPC Academy
